Nigerian Higher Education Institutions in Lagos Launch Connectivity Project.

Lagos - 1st December 2009 - The Lagos Higher Education Connectivity Project (LHECP) aka Eko-Konnect launches on 15th December in University of Lagos with a seminar on collaboration for research and education. The multi-institutional project initiated by the University of Lagos in partnership with the Internet Exchange Point of Nigeria and Datasphir Solutions aims to facilitate and support network connectivity between all Higher Education Institutions (HEI's) in Lagos including mono/polytechnics, colleges of education, Research Institutions and universities.

The LHECP hopes to catalyse the ongoing development of the Nigerian Research and Education Network (NgREN) by fostering collaborative research in network technology, development and sharing of content, applications and other resources as well as stimulate capacity building.
